## 1 SECTION 1. RESTRICTION OF CERTAIN COMMERCIAL AIR-

- 2 CRAFT ARRIVALS.
- 3 (a) FLIGHT RESTRICTION.—Beginning on the date of
- 4 enactment of this Act, the Administrator of the Federal
- 5 Aviation Administration shall ban the arrival of any com-
- 6 mercial aircraft from a foreign country in which the Ebola
